## **Important Information**

- Please make check or money order payable to South Alabama Utilities.
- Failure to receive a bill does not exempt you from a monthly payment, penalty, or disconnection.
- Payment must be received by the Due Date on the statement to avoid a late charge.
- A \$40.00 fee will be charged for returned checks.
- If service is disconnected, account will subject to reconnection fees and account balance paid in full before service is turned back on.
- Tampering with a locked service will result in additional fees and possible criminal charges.
- A fee may be charged if a customer requests the meter to be re-read and there is no error.

## DECENTRALIZED WASTEWATER REMINDERS (DO's & DON'Ts)

- Do collect grease in a container and dispose of it with your trash.
- Do use your trash can to dispose of substances that can cause maintenance problems and/or increase the need for septage pumping.
- Do familiarize yourself with the location of your wastewater system and electrical panel. You may silence the alarm and then report the alarm to SAU.
- Don't ever put grease or flushable wipes into your wastewater system!
- Don't get stuck with a bill for additional tank maintenance or repair because your family or guest ignored these guidelines.


